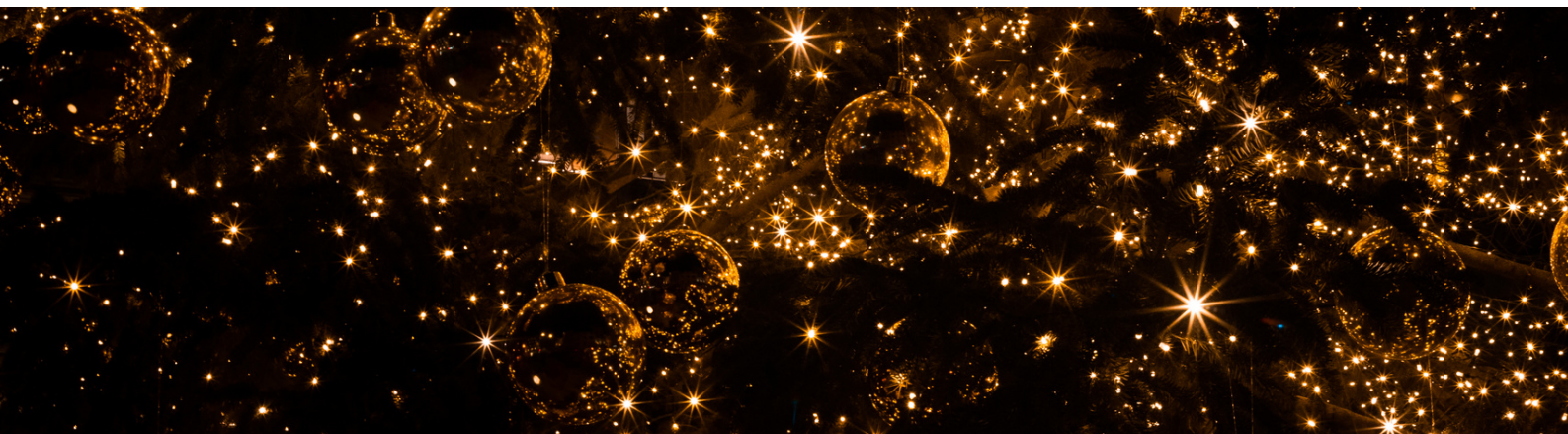
Toddler 1
