Tiger Room

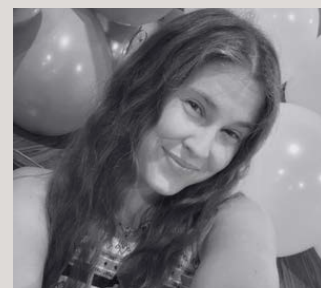
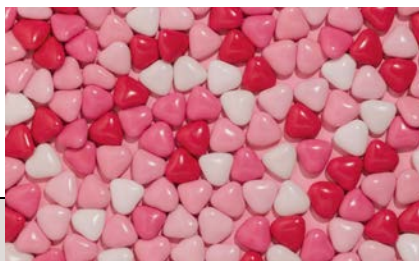
Hello Tiger Families!

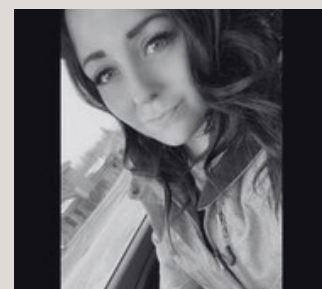
