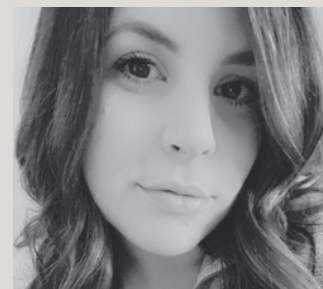

Hello Turtle Families!

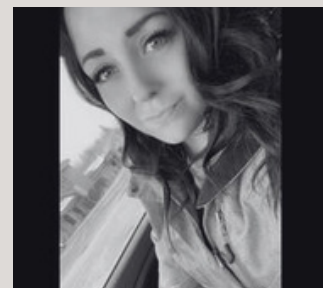
